Transportation

Our buses traditionally run double routes with buses at a capacity of 72 students. To meet the CDC guidelines, busing capacity would need to be reduced to 11 students per bus with students sitting every other seat. Under such limitations, this is practically impossible for the District to transport students given the size of the bus fleet and available drivers. After consulting with the Marathon County Health Department, we believe the following options below may provide solutions to safely transport students to and from school.



- Adults on bus are wearing face masks and or shields
- Adults and Students on bus are wearing face masks or shields

Our primary plan is to bring all students back to the schools in the fall. Families will have the option to enroll their child(ren) in the Wausau School District's WAVE (Wausau Area Virtual Education) program if they are not comfortable sending them back to school. We are in the process of creating an alternate plan if we cannot bring all students back to school at once, or if we should need to close down for an extended period of time mid-year. This plan would allow for better opportunities to socially distance with fewer students in the school on a daily basis.
