Tobacco Use

The extreme health risks associated with the use of tobacco are well-established. In addition, students under the age of eighteen (18) are generally prohibited by law from purchasing or possessing tobacco products. Accordingly, all students are prohibited from using, possessing, or distributing tobacco on District premises, on property owned, leased, rented by, or under the control of the District, and at all school-sponsored activities.

For the purposes of this Policy, "tobacco" includes, but is not limited to, cigarettes (including clove cigarettes, bidi cigarettes, electronic cigarettes, nicotine vaporizers, and other substitute forms of cigarettes); cigars, loose tobacco, smokeless tobacco (including dipping tobacco, chewing tobacco, and snuff); liquid nicotine, and other substances containing tobacco or nicotine.
