

## Human Growth and Development

The Wausau School District offers human growth and development instruction as part of a comprehensive health curriculum.

If your son/daughter is to receive instruction during this school year you will be notified by the school and provided with an outline of the topics to be covered as part of the human growth and development instruction. If you desire more specific information, you may contact the Education Department at Longfellow Administration Center (715-261-0527) to arrange to review all curricular and instructional materials for your son's/daughter's grade level .

No student in the District may be required to take/receive instruction in human growth and development. As a parent/guardian, you have the option to exempt your son/daughter from all or part of the human growth and development instruction by filing a written request (see form below) with the school your son/daughter attends. Should you decide to remove your son/daughter from human growth and development instruction, he/she will still be required to receive alternate instruction in subjects under State Statute 118.01(2)(d)8.
