*The [Wisconsin Student Immunization Law](#) requires that all students through grade 12 meet a minimum number of required immunizations prior to school entrance. These requirements can be waived only for health, religious, or personal conviction reasons.*

**Almost every child entering kindergarten or 6th grade this fall needs a “booster” shot.**

Please contact your child’s doctor for advice, and make an appointment for your child to get immunized as soon as possible.

If you choose not to have your child immunized, please sign an [Immunization Waiver](#) and return it to your child’s school before school resumes.

If you have any questions or concerns, please contact your school nurse.
