

As the start of the 2020-2021 school year gets closer, here are a few things you should know:

1. Ready to Start School conferences will be happening at our elementary, middle, and high schools. For elementary students, they're scheduled for September 1-3, and for middle and high schools they're scheduled for September 1-4. You will be receiving more information about the conferences, how they will work, and scheduling a time from your child(ren)'s principal within the next week.
2. Full virtual learning will begin the day after Labor Day, which is September 8. More information about how the virtual day will look will also be coming from your child(ren)'s school.
3. If your child(ren) has an IEP, case managers will begin reaching out to you. So, expect to hear from them soon.
