■ **Superkids Go To Camp: for students currently in kindergarten**

Literacy skills, language skills, enrichment activities, physical education, and art keep students engaged as they spend the summer with “Superkids.” The program reinforces and enriches the literacy skills students were exposed to during kindergarten as part of the Wausau School District’s core literacy program. Students remain with the same teacher for the entire morning.

■ **Funny Things & Buggy Bugs: for students currently in grade 1**

Students will explore reading, writing, math, technology, and learn about funny things, buggy bugs, names, farms, teeth, and why a frog is blue. Students have the opportunity to participate in art, games, physical education, and science activities.

■ **Celebrity Citizens: for students currently in grade 2**

Students study various aspects of the community and understand how they work together to create a town. Students also use Reader’s Theatre and play-acting to practice their new respectful citizen skills. Students will learn about the fire department, public works, government, grocery shopping, and taking care of our environment. Students become “Celebrity Citizens” and focus math, writing, and reading skills on our special guest speakers from the community.

■ **Trail Blazers: for students currently in grade 3**

Trail Blazers is an exciting program for all third grade students to explore Wisconsin’s great outdoors on the Ice Age Trail and in the classroom! Students will navigate through a variety of math, reading, writing, social studies, and science activities on a journey through Wisconsin’s history from prehistoric times to today. Weekly hiking trips on varying segments of the Ice Age Trail allow students to experience the geological and environmental aspects of Wisconsin’s landscape.

■ **Fit Kids Adventure Camp: for students currently in grade 4**

Fourth graders who want to power up their bodies and minds with fun sports and healthy activities would enjoy this camp! Exciting reading, math, and enrichment activities integrate into a sports theme each week. There are technology opportunities as well. Weekly special field trips are also part of this exciting summer adventure for all fourth graders.
