Question #1 - \$155,000,000

BOND IS FOR BUILDING

If approved, keeps tax rate the same (due to old debt being replaced with new) while funding necessary building improvements and maintenance. These dollars would be used for a new elementary school to serve Grant and Lincoln students, district-wide safety and security updates, elementary and middle school remodels and additions, modernization, infrastructure and technology improvements.

LEVY IS FOR LEARNING

If approved, keeps tax rate the same (due to old debt being replaced with new) while funding the additional staffing needed to provide full pupil service teams at each elementary school. These dollars would also be used for operational expenses.



Stettin Elementary

If passed, the November 3rd referendum would include the funding needed to make the following improvements at Stettin:

Safety & Security Enhancements

- Reconfigure main entrance to secure entry and control visitor access
- Upgrade fire alarm, clock and PA systems, emergency generator

Learning Space Modernization

- Build classroom addition with resource room and six new classrooms (grades 4 and 5)
- Add two Kindergarten Classrooms
- Create a Community Room for co-curricular and community events
- Remodel classrooms near IMC to create Science Room and maker space for project-based learning
- Reconfigure grade-level classrooms
- ADA upgrades
- Update technology (equipment, spaces, access)

Building Repairs

- Address required maintenance (LED lighting, flooring, sidewalk repairs)
- Update playground surfaces and equipment
- Expand parking

Student Support Space Expansions

- Remodel and repurpose existing classrooms for dedicated Special Education and Sensory rooms
- Add staff to provide full pupil services teams (Question #2)
