Students remain with the same teacher for the entire morning and focus on the skills necessary for a successful transition to kindergarten.

- Look for your child's notification letter and bus information the week of May 31, 2022

When registering online, please note if you register for an AM course, it must read 33% complete when you are done. If you register for an AM and PM course, it must read 67% complete when you are done. If you register for AM, PM and Week 7 it will say 100%.
